WHAT IS A DWAI/DUI?

■ DWAI:

Driving While Ability Impaired:

If your ability is impaired to the "slightest degree" by alcohol, drugs or even prescription medications, or if your blood alcohol content (BAC) is found to be **at or above .05 percent but less than .08 percent**.

■ DUI:

Driving Under the Influence:

If you are "substantially incapable" of operating a vehicle after consuming alcohol, drugs or prescription medications, or if your blood alcohol concentration (BAC) is **at or above .08 percent**.

COST OF A DUI:

\$13,530

With so much at stake, don't take the chance of getting a DUI/DWAI.

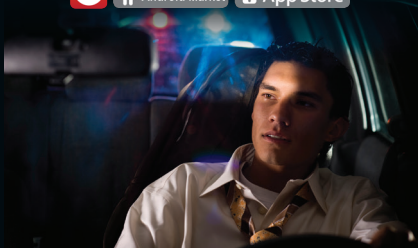
